Aportaciones Especiales SA: This short film is about the company which belongs to the sector of construction and metals of transport or other machines in general, it's the most popular company in Madrid. The company was found in 1973 by the two brothers Carlos Forcada and Juaquin Forcada. Podini: In this 5 minute short movie the viewers will be able to take a look at the most high end sprout farm in Latvia, which has been established in 1967 and specialized on growing spruce, birch and alder saplings, our main excursion led by Jānis Siksaliētis, the manager of the company, through the sprout farm where he will learn how the growing and selling process of the sprouts is happening, what kind of machinery they use to harvest and sort the saplings and how exactly they are being stored and taken care of. **Ticket Price: 6,50 €**



Curahadoglu: Cuhadaroglu is a familial company that produces aluminum and metal. It was found in 1954 by Ahmet Cuhadaroglu and is one of the biggest companies in the sector of metal production. They started with 5 workers and today they have over 1000 workers. Their products are used for construction, automotive, public transportation, packaging etc. sectors. The companies CEO is Mr. ARACI. We asked some questions about aluminum and Cuhadaroglu's history Mr. ARACI answered our questions. He says aluminum's corrosion resistance rate is high and aluminum has started to increase after 1950s. **Ticket Price: 6,50 €**



Kosmos: The movie is about a factory which produces sweets and sells them to the pastry shops. Firstly we learn that the factory was established in 2004 and it preexisted as two different corps. The inventors are Mr. Chouvardas and Mr. Triantafyllou. Also, the workers are 40 and the inventors work there too and in last 4-5 they opened 3 shops in the central Thessaloniki. They only provide pastry shops and bakeries, which they don't make their own sweets. They produce everything relevant with confectionery. In addition, the factory was affected by the economic crisis that started 5-6 years ago. Furthermore, people of all ages buy their products and the secret that make their sweets so good is the excellent quality and their competitive prices. Last but not least their future goals are to develop their network and open more shops in Thessaloniki. **Ticket Price: 6,50 €**





Sovena: This movie is about the factory “Sovena” that produces oil and olive oil that is mostly used by all the Portuguese population. This factory also sells their products to other countries, such as Spain, Brazil, Morocco, The United States and Italy. The company had a really big development in 1974, when a business man called Jorge de Mello decided to buy a factory called ALCO in the north of the country and another factory in the south. The operations with other countries only started when Sovena bought “Agribetica” in Seville.

Ramponi: During our visit at this company we interviewed the general manager Mr. Marco Bertolina who explained us the history of the company and the family who founded it. The business was born in 1988 by the hand of Mr. Ramponi and focuses its products on studs and ABS (plastic studs) on order of greater Italian brands as Valentino and D&G and other Swiss and French trademarks. The Ramponi’s objective is to export its products on foreign markets, opening new branches in Japan and in America. The business is product oriented as it concentrates on the quality of the product and on the speed of its delivery. The company’s members think about renovating the firm every day, introducing many developments as the partnership with “Milano Politecnico” for the research of new materials.

Giesers: GiesersBau is a factory in Bocholt which produces mostly steel. It was founded in 1950 by Wilhelm Giesers and only had a few employees. In the video we asked an employee about the history of the company but also about their plans for the future. GiesersBau once made gates, but nowadays they build halls for the industrial sectors of other companies, for example for construction companies and warehouses.
